

CONTEST RULES

„Wygraj 5g of gold”

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1.1. The Organiser of the Contest is DIGITAL SOLUTIONS 98 SPÓŁKA Z OGRANICZONĄ ODPOWIEDZIALNOŚCIĄ with its registered office in Kraków (registered address: Józefa Marcika 4, 30-443 Kraków and correspondence address: ul. Józefa Marcika 4, 30-443 Kraków), entered in the register of entrepreneurs of the National Court Register under KRS number: 0000903028; registration court: District Court for Kraków – Śródmieście in Kraków, XII Commercial Division of the National Court Register; share capital: PLN 6,000.00; NIP 9442271976, REGON 389017246, email: kontakt@shav.pl, phone: +48 690 801 270.
- 1.2. The Contest is organised in the Organiser's Online Store.
- 1.3. The provision by the Participant of information and data related to their participation in the Contest, including personal data, is voluntary, but may be necessary for the proper conduct of the Contest. Failure to provide the required information and data, including personal data indicated in the Rules below, will prevent the Participant from taking part in the Contest. Detailed information on the principles of processing personal data of Contest Participants is provided in point 4 of the Rules.
- 1.4. A Participant may withdraw from the Contest at any time by notifying the Organiser.
- 1.5. Definitions – terms used in the Rules mean:
- 1.5.1. CIVIL CODE – the Act – Civil Code of 23 April 1964 (Journal of Laws 1964, No. 16, item 93, as amended).
- 1.5.2. CONTEST COMMITTEE – a committee appointed by the Organiser to ensure the proper organisation and conduct of the Contest, in particular to assess the correctness of Contest entries and to determine the winners.
- 1.5.3. CONTEST – this contest organised by the Organiser in accordance with the Rules.
- 1.5.4. ORGANISER / DATA CONTROLLER – DIGITAL SOLUTIONS 98 SPÓŁKA Z OGRANICZONĄ ODPOWIEDZIALNOŚCIĄ with its registered office in Kraków (registered address: Józefa Marcika 4, 30-443 Kraków), KRS: 0000903028, NIP 9442271976, email: kontakt@shav.pl, phone: +48 690 801 270.
- 1.5.5. RULES – these Contest rules.
- 1.5.6. ONLINE STORE – the Organiser's online store available at <https://shav.pl/>.
- 1.5.7. PARTICIPANT – a natural person who participates in the Contest and additionally meets the requirements set out in point 2 of the Contest Rules.
- 1.5.8. CONTEST TASK – a task consisting of completing the Contest Form by the Participant and answering the question: "Why do you like the Shav razor and why should you win the prize?"

2. CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- 2.1. Participation in the Contest is voluntary and free of charge.
- 2.2. The Contest is organised in the Organiser's Online Store.
- 2.3. The conditions for participation in the Contest are cumulatively:
- 2.3.1. concluding a sales contract with the Organiser (purchasing a product) via the Online Store or Allegro;
- 2.3.2. reading the content of the Rules below before participating in the Contest;
- 2.3.3. completing and submitting the Contest Task during the Contest period by completing and sending the contest form to the Organiser.
- 2.4. Every customer who makes a purchase in the Organiser's Online Store during the Contest period will receive from the Organiser an email with a contest form. If the customer decides to participate in the Contest, they should provide their name and surname, order number and answer the question: "Why do you like the Shav razor and why should you win the prize?" in the form. The answer can be entered directly in the form or recorded as a video on TikTok or Instagram and the link to the recording pasted in the appropriate field in the form. An additional condition for participation in the Contest is posting a personal review of the Shav razor on the Organiser's Google Business Profile.
- 2.5. Each Participant may complete the Contest Task only once. If the same Participant completes the Contest Task more than once, the Organiser will consider only the first submission in order of receipt.
- 2.6. The Contest Task should be completed independently by the Participant, should be an original work that has not been previously published, including on the Internet. The Participant, when completing and submitting the Contest Task to the Organiser, is required to hold full personal and economic copyright therein.
- 2.7. The Participant, in particular in connection with completing and submitting the Contest Task, is prohibited from providing unlawful content. Content provided by the Participant, in particular as part of the Contest Task, should comply with the law and good practices, with respect for personal rights and copyrights and intellectual property of the Organiser and third parties, and should not contain vulgar, offensive or socially unacceptable language.

Information provided by the Participant in connection with participation in the Contest should be authentic, consistent with the facts and not misleading.

- 2.8. In the case of a Contest Task in the form of a video posted on Instagram or TikTok, the Participant's activities within the Contest should not violate the terms of service of Instagram (available at: <https://help.instagram.com/581066165581870>) or TikTok (available at: <https://www.tiktok.com/legal/page/eea/terms-of-service/pl-PL>).
- 2.9. The Organiser has the right to exclude from the Contest Participants whose actions are contrary to the law, these Rules or the terms of service of Instagram or TikTok.
- 2.10. Employees and associates of the Organiser and other persons who participated in the preparation or organisation of the Contest, as well as members of their immediate families, are excluded from participation in the Contest. Immediate family members include: ascendants, descendants, siblings, spouses, parents of spouses and persons in an adoptive relationship.

3. CONTEST RULES AND ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS

- 3.1. The Contest runs from 12.05.2026 to 27.05.2026.
- 3.2. In order to select the winners and ensure the proper course of the Contest, the Organiser has appointed a Contest Committee consisting of 3 persons. The Contest Committee will freely select the winning Contest Tasks, guided by its own judgement, taking into account the relevance, consistency with the Contest theme, originality, creativity and artistic merits of the Participant's Contest Task.
- 3.3. 1 winner will be selected in the Contest. The prizes in the Contest are as follows:
 - 3.3.1. 1st place: 5g of gold, value PLN 2,900;
- 3.4. The Contest result will be announced by 02.06.2026 by publishing information about the winners (first and last name) in the Organiser's Online Store and on the Organiser's Instagram account. The Organiser will also contact the winning Participants by sending them messages about their winnings to the email addresses provided when placing orders. Each winner is required to contact the Organiser immediately, but no later than within 7 calendar days from the date of the announcement of the result, and provide the Organiser with the data necessary for delivery of the prize (first and last name, delivery address, email address and contact phone number). The condition for awarding the prize is the provision of all data within the above-mentioned deadline and indication of a delivery address in the territory of the Republic of Poland.
- 3.5. If a Participant fails to meet the conditions set out in point 3.4 above, the Organiser shall be entitled to select an alternative winner to whom the prize will be awarded.
- 3.6. The prize will be delivered by courier to the address provided by the winner within 7 calendar days from the date of its submission to the Organiser.
- 3.7. The winner may waive the right to the prize, but may not transfer the right to the prize to a third party or request the exchange of the prize for a cash equivalent or any other form of compensation.
- 3.8. If the prize is subject to taxation, the Contest winner will be awarded an additional cash prize equal to the tax that the Contest winner is required to pay on the winnings. The additional cash prize referred to in the preceding sentence shall not be paid out and shall be used to cover the flat-rate tax referred to in Art. 30 para. 1 point 2 of the Act of 26 July 1991 on personal income tax. This tax will be withheld by the Contest Organiser and remitted to the relevant tax office.

4. PRIVACY POLICY

- 4.1. The controller of personal data processed in connection with the implementation of the provisions of these Rules is the Organiser. Personal data is processed in accordance with applicable law, in particular Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation – "GDPR"). - 4.2. The Controller processes personal data for the purposes, to the extent and based on the principles indicated in this point of the Rules. Providing personal data is voluntary, however failure to provide personal data necessary for participation in the Contest results in the inability to participate.
- 4.3. In accordance with GDPR, the Controller is authorised to process personal data where – and to the extent that – at least one of the following conditions is met: (1) the data subject has given consent to the processing of their personal data for one or more specific purposes; (2) processing is necessary for the performance of a contract

to which the data subject is a party, or to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering the Contest; (3) processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the Controller is subject; or (4) processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller or by a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject.

4.4. The processing of personal data by the Controller requires the existence of at least one of the bases indicated above. The specific legal bases for processing personal data of Participants by the Controller are indicated in the next point of the Rules – in relation to the specific purpose of personal data processing.

4.5. The Controller may process personal data for the following purposes, on the following legal bases and for the following periods:

Organisation of the Contest	Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR (legitimate interests) – processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller, namely the proper organisation and conduct of the Contest and the delivery of prizes to the winners. Direct marketing	Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR (legitimate interests) – processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller, namely the proper organisation and conduct of the Contest and the delivery of prizes to the winners.	Data is stored for the period of the legitimate interest pursued by the Controller, but no longer than for the period of limitation of claims against the data subject due to the Controller's business activity. The limitation period is determined by law, in particular the Civil Code.
Establishment, pursuit or defence of claims that may be raised by the Controller or that may be raised against the Controller	Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR (legitimate interests) – processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller, namely the proper organisation and conduct of the Contest and the delivery of prizes to the winners.	Data is stored for the period of the legitimate interest pursued by the Controller, but no longer than for the period of limitation of claims against the data subject due to the Controller's business activity. The limitation period is determined by law, in particular the Civil Code.

4.6. The organisation of the Contest requires the Controller to use the services of external entities. The Controller uses only the services of such processors who provide sufficient guarantees of implementing appropriate technical and organisational measures, so that the processing meets the requirements of the GDPR and protects the rights of data subjects. The Controller transfers data only when necessary for the given purpose of personal data processing and only to the extent necessary for its realisation. Participants' personal data may be transferred to the following recipients or categories of recipients:

4.6.1. providers of technical, IT and organisational solutions supplying the Controller with tools enabling the Controller to conduct its business (in particular carriers, software providers, email and hosting providers, and providers of business management and technical support software) – the Controller shares collected personal data of the Participant with a selected provider acting on its behalf only in cases and to the extent necessary for the realisation of the given purpose of data processing consistent with this point 4 of the Rules.

4.6.2. providers of legal and advisory services providing the Controller with accounting, legal or advisory support (in particular a law firm) – the Controller shares collected personal data of the Participant with a selected provider acting on its behalf only in cases and to the extent necessary for the realisation of the given purpose of data processing consistent with this point 4 of the Rules.

4.7. The data subject has the following rights:

4.7.1. Right of access, rectification, restriction, erasure or portability – the data subject has the right to request from the Controller access to their personal data, its rectification, erasure ("right to be forgotten") or restriction of processing, and has the right to object to processing, as well as the right to data portability. Detailed conditions for exercising the above rights are set out in Articles 15–21 of the GDPR.

4.7.2. Right to withdraw consent at any time – a person whose data is processed by the Controller on the basis of expressed consent (pursuant to Art. 6(1)(a) or Art. 9(2)(a) of the GDPR) has the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.

4.7.3. Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority – a person whose data is processed by the Controller has the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority in the manner and procedure specified in the GDPR and Polish law, in particular the Personal Data Protection Act. The supervisory authority in Poland is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.

4.7.4. Right to object – the data subject has the right to object at any time – on grounds relating to their particular situation – to processing of personal data concerning them based on Art. 6(1)(e) (public interest or official authority) or (f) (legitimate interests), including profiling based on those provisions. In such a case, the Controller may no longer process that personal data unless it demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject, or grounds for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

4.7.5. Right to object to direct marketing – if personal data is processed for direct marketing purposes, the data subject has the right to object at any time to processing of personal data concerning them for such marketing, including profiling, to the extent that the processing is related to such direct marketing.

4.8. To exercise the rights referred to in the above point of the Rules, you may contact the Controller by sending an appropriate message in writing or by electronic mail to the Controller's address indicated at the beginning of the Rules.

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6. COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE

6.1. Complaints related to the Contest may be submitted by the Participant, for example, via email to: kontakt@shav.pl or in writing to the Organiser's address: Józefa Marcika 4, 30-443 Kraków.

6.2. It is recommended to include in the complaint description as much information and circumstances regarding the subject of the complaint as possible, in particular the type and date of the irregularity, contact details and the expectations of the person submitting the complaint – this will facilitate and speed up the consideration of the complaint by the Organiser.

6.3. The Organiser shall respond to the complaint without undue delay, no later than within 14 days of its submission.

6.4. The rules for submitting and handling complaints set out in the Rules do not in any way limit the Participant's right to bring a claim before a competent court.

7. FINAL PROVISIONS

7.1. The law applicable to the organisation of the Contest is Polish law.

7.2. The Organiser declares that the Contest is not a lottery, raffle, mutual bet, promotional lottery, game whose result depends on chance, or any other form subject to the provisions of the Act of 19 November 2009 on gambling.

7.3. In matters not regulated by these Rules, the provisions of the Civil Code and other applicable provisions of Polish law shall apply.

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
